Each year the State Education Committee with the help of SCFCL Advisors and support of Clemson University Family and Consumer Science Department select education lessons to improve the quality of life for members and their families. Topics are suggested by the Education Committee with input from FCL Members. The lessons are prepared, reviewed, and printed then distributed to each county at the Fall District meeting. It takes 4 months to write, edit, review and print the lessons in order for them to be ready for distribution at the fall district meetings.

The Club Education Report should be distributed to all clubs. Club selects the lessons to be used and returns the report to the County President by **September 1**. The County President collects the Club Reports, assembles the information onto the County Education Report and sends the County Report to the SCFCL President by **October 1**. The County Report provides excellent feedback on which topics are used, how many members have access to this information and which lessons are actually used by clubs.
